The tour, conducted by Jeff Case and Mary Brush, of the famed Holabird & Root architecture firm (founded in 1880 and responsible for structures such as The Chicago Board of Trade and Soldier Field, as well as the recent restoration of the Tiffany art glass dome at the Chicago Cultural Center), will include the Blackstone Hotel, Hilton Chicago, Auditorium Theater, Mandel Bros. Warehouse, old St. Luke's Hospital, and more.
